

## Anti-Rabies Vaccination (Walk-in clients)

### ☑ ABOUT THE SERVICE

Pursuant to the provision of Provincial Ordinance No. 2007-012 particularly in Section 6, "Mandatory Dog Registration and Vaccination is ordered yearly." Dog owners with dogs age 3 months and older are mandated to register them to the Bantay Rabies sa Barangay Council (BRBC) in their barangay. Registration is renewable every year onward. This entitles the dog to an anti-rabies vaccination, dog tag and registration certificate/card. Massive dog vaccination is conducted to all the barangays in Jagna particularly during the months of February, March and April. Dogs that were not vaccinated during these schedules in the barangay will still have the chance to be vaccinated. Dog owners are advised to register their dogs first with the BRBC and bring them at the Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO) for them to be vaccinated.
