MUNICIPALITY OF JAGNA, JAGNA, BOHOL POST-DAMAGE ASSESSMENT REPORT As of November 30, 2014 As of 5:00 PM

1. EFFECTS OF THE TROPICAL DEPRESSION "QUEENIE" IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF JAGNA, BOHOL

- **AFFECTED AREAS** – 33 Barangays of the Municipality of Jagna, Bohol Province, Region VII but severely affected the 14 coastal barangays namely Canuba, Ipil, Cantagay, Bunga Mar, Can-upao, Looc, Pagina, Poblacion, Pangdan, Nausok, Larapan, Tubod Mar, Naatang and Alejawan with houses and fishing boats totally and partially damaged. There were also damaged reported from agricultural crops and livestock.

- **CASUALTIES**

Dead: four (4)

1. Chief Engr. Cesario Dela Serna – 59 (Liloan, Cebu)
2. Mr. Roque Sandoval – 62 Fisherman (Mindanao)
3. Mr. Robinson Ceballos – 32 Fisherman (Bunga Mar, Jagna)
4. Mr. Adrian S. Sagrado – 26 Fisherman (Guintabuan, Ubay, Bohol)

Injured: two (2) adult in Barangay Bunga Mar

1. Bonifacio Achas – 38 fisherman - ok
2. Esmeraldo Sajol – 54 fisherman - ok

1. Mr. Oscar Biasa – 59 Fisherman (Mindanao)

- **45** - Totally Damaged/Destroyed

- **416** - Partially Damaged/Destroyed

- **FISHING VESSEL/FISHING BOATS**

- **225** –totally damaged

- **AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION:**

- Alejawan- damaged to crops such as vegetables (5 hectares), coconut (100trees),banana (600 hills) approximately amounted to P 450,000.00

3. EMERGENCY RESPONSE OPERATIONS/ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN

- Activate MDRRMC (Incident Command Center) to monitor the effects of TD Queenie and conduct meeting in coordination with BDRRM Action Officers of each barangays
- MDRRMC with Jagna Emergency Medical Rescue Unit Team conducts rapid damaged assessment activities to all barangays in Jagna, analyzed the effects of damaged based on the criteria and qualifies to recommend for declaration of a state of calamity;
- Convene MDRRMC in a quorum and recommend to 8th Sanggunian Bayan for the Declaration of the State of Calamity.
- The 8th Sangguniang Bayan of the municipality of Jagna in a quorum session approves to declare a State of Calamity in the morning on November 27, 2014 thru ***SB Resolution No. 150-11-2014.***
- Jagna Emergency and Rescue Unit (JEMRU) conducted search and rescue operation along the coast of Bunga Mar, Jagna with assistance from Bureau of Fire Protection;
- On-going consolidation of reports from the barangay DRRM Action Officers/Punong Barangays at the Incident Command Center;
- Extend relief goods from the LGU to the 512 affected families in the municipalities;
- Received 750 packs of relief goods form DSWD 7.
- Electricity restored around 6:34 in the afternoon of November 27, 2015;

- Coordination with the Provincial Government thru TARSIER 117 headed by the PDRRMO Mr. A. Damalerio for the technical assistance in the search and rescue operation in the evening of November 27, 2014;
- Philippine Coast Guard helps in the operation on November 28, 2014 with the JEMRU personnel and successfully recover the dead body of Mr. Roque Sandoval along the coast of Can-upao near Jagna Cockpit Arena around 7:45 in the morning;
- Around 9:35 on November 27, 2014 another dead body of Mr. Robinson Ceballos recovered along the shorelines of Bunga Mar, Jagna, Bohol;
- PAGASA Central Office Team conducted validation and investigation of the wind wave traces;
- Current search and rescue operation by local divers up to this present time for the remaining one (1) person missing

- b. Ready mobilization/emergency support funds;




