EFFECTS OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION “SENIANG”

### **I. Situationer**

BOHOL IS NOW SIGNAL NO. 2 as of 9:00 AM of December 29, 2014. Tropical Storm "Seniang" had made landfall over Bakulin, Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur and it will traverse BOHOL SEA. It will bring heavy rains and bigwaves that reaches to 5.0 meters. It has maximum sustained winds of 65 kph and gustiness of 80kph moving WNW at 11kph.

### **II. MDRRMC ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN**

1. Convene MDRRMC at Capt. Goyo Hall for Command Post activation and the following are some of the action points to undertake
  - a. To activate and operationalized DRRM Command Center at Municipal Agriculture's Office
  - b. Conducted rekoreda to all coastal barangays to encourage coastal residents to seek refuge in higher grounds;
  - c. To activate barangay DRRM Committee and heighten a Seniang
  - d. Relief goods preparation discussed;
  - e. Reserved funds for mobilization ensured by municipal Treasurer
  - f. To render reports to provincial DRRM and DILG by 10AM and every 6 hours after
  - g. Transportation and mobilization for the operation in-charged by Mr. Eriberto Ranin
  - h. Information dissemination of the tropical and next advisory
2. Other Matter discussed
  - a. Residents near rivers and creeks should vigilant and alerted for safety against possible flashfloods due to heavy rainfall;
  - b. Tasking of duty at the Command Center to all regular and job order personnel in a shifting schedule pre-arranged by office as follows:
    - i. Dec 29, 2014 @ 12NN-6PM – MAYOR'S OFFICE PERSONNEL
    - ii. Dec 29, 2014@ 6PM-12MN – Municipal Agriculture's Office Personnel

- iii. Dec 30, 2014 @12MN-6AM – Municipal Assessor’s Office Personnel
  - iv. Dec 30, 2014@6AM-12NN – Municipal Engineering Office Personnel
  - v. Dec 30, 2014@12NN-6PM – Jagna Waterworks System Personnel
  - vi. Dec 30, 2014@6PM-12MN – SB personnel and 8<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Bayan
- c. Protective Devices Needed
- i. Raincoats for on duty field responder and rescuer

3. Other Important Notes
- a. Engr. Josefina Ranoa municipal engineer submitted a validated reports for damaged houses during the TD Queenie;

  - c. Motor siren is not functional due to short circuits; spare parts to be secure for rapairs;
