Executive Order No. 12, s. 2013

RECONSTITUTING THE MEMBERS OF THE MUNICIPAL GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (MGAD-C) AND RELATED INSTITUTIONAL MECHANISMS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE MODIFIED GAD CODE OF JAGNA, BOHOL AND TO THE ORDINANCE ENACTING THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR) OF THE MODIFIED GAD CODE (M.O. 2-03-2012)

WHEREAS, the translation of the Gender and Development Framework from theory into practice is through the gender mainstreaming strategy;

WHEREAS, PCW Memorandum Circular No. 2011-01 providing guidelines in the creation, strengthening and institutionalization of the Gender And Development (GAD) Focal Point System;

WHEREAS, the Gender and Development Councils (GAD Focal Point System) are among the GAD mechanism to accelerate gender mainstreaming in the local government units;

WHEREAS, the MGAD-C is task to implement Joint Circular No. 2012-01 of Philippine Commission on Women (PCW), National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA), Department of Budget and Management (DBM) provides guidelines in the preparation of Annual Gender and Development (GAD) Plans and Budget and Accomplishment Reports to Implement the Magna Carta of Women;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Jagna has adopted gender mainstreaming in its governance by integrating gender perspectives in planning and policies as well as in the delivery of gender-responsive PPS.

WHEREAS, the enacted GAD Code IRR provides for the enhancement of the institutional mechanisms among which is the MGAD-C and committees/structures under its primarily responsible to carry out the general objective of the GAD Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FORTUNATO R. ABRENILLA, by virtue of the Power vested in me by law as Mayor of the Municipality of Jagna, hereby order the reconstitution of the Municipal GAD Council (MGAD-C) and its committees and structures as follows:

Section 2. Functions, Roles and Responsibilities of the Jagna GAD Council

a) Formulates the annual GAD Plan and Budget to be integrated in the annual investment plan;

- b) Meets every six months to monitor the implementation of plans and responds to issues and concerns related to GAD or can hold special meeting as it deems
- c) Adopts and employs GAD monitoring indicators and evaluation checklists and tools to be applied to the municipal and barangay units, Sectoral organizations and the community;
- d) Assesses and evaluates the implementation of the GAD plan and prepares annual report regarding the accomplishment, good practices and lessons on GAD and reports the same;
- e) Coordinates and establish linkage with agencies, institutions and organizations for partnership and Networking and the implementation of the GAD IRR;
- f) Undertakes consciousness-raising programs and projects through Information, Education and Communication campaigns (trainings and trainor training, workshops);
- g) Ensures the organizing and strengthening of women organizations in the municipality and their representation in the special bodies; and

Section 3. GAD Office, GAD Resource Center and GAD Focal Person The GAD Office shall be manned by Ms. Marcionila E. Reyes, GAD Focal Point to be assisted by Ms. Eulalia Saburnido and Ms. Liliosa dela Merced.

3.1 Functions and Responsibilities

- a. GAD Focal Person is responsible for the facilitation and monitoring of the implementation of gender mainstreaming in the LGU.
- b. The staff of the GAD Office cum GAD Resource Center shall serve as secretariat to provide administrative and logistical support to the MGAD-Council
- c. The GAD Office shall serve as the center of GAD activities
- d. The GAD Resource Center shall respond to the needs of GAD mainstreaming with the following services:
 - Capacity development programs and modules
 - o Technical assistance on development of policy and PPAs, M&E and other related concerns;
 - o Production-dissemination of IEC materials

Section 4. Committees under the MGAD-C. To effectively respond to the challenges in the cause to promote, protect and fulfill the rights of women and children, the following committees shall be created as integral part of the council and shall work in coordination with the respective departments and offices in and outside of the LGU.

- o Committee on Gender-based Violence
- o Committee on the Economic Empowerment of Women
- o Committee on Reproductive Health
- o Committee on Education, Training and Research
