#### 1. TYPE OF DISASTER/SITUATION OVERVIEW

- Tropical Depression "QUEENIE" has maintained its strength as it continues to move closer toward the Eastern section of Mindanao.
- Winds of 30-60 kph is expected in at least 36 hours
- Under Signal No.1
  - Southern Levte
  - o Bohol
  - Southern Cebu
  - Negros Oriental
  - Southern Negros Occidental Siguijor
- Estimated rainfall amount is from 7 15 mm per hour (moderate heavy) within the 300 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.
  Residents in low lying and mountainous areas of the provinces with PSWS#1 as well as the rest of Mindanao are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.
- Around 11:30 to 12:30 midnight, storm surge was experienced with a run-off of 70-100 meters, with approximate height of 10-15 feet.
- Total black out experienced around 11:00 PM of November 26, 2014 and was restored at 4:00 PM of November 27, 2014.

# **EMERGENCY RESPONSE OPERATIONS/ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN**

- a. Activate MDRRMC (Incident Command Center) to monitor the effects of TD Queenie and conduct meeting in coordination with BDRRM Action Officers of each barangays
- b. Convene MDRRMC in a quorum and recommend to 8<sup>th</sup> Sanggunian Bayan for the Declaration of the State of Calamity
- c. Conduct damage assessment More particularly in 14 coastal barangays
- d. Jagna Emergency and Rescue Unit (JEMRU) attended to search and rescue operation along the coast of Bunga Mar, Jagna
- e. On-going consolidation of reports from the barangay DRRM Action Officers/Punong Barangays

- f. 495 families extended with relief goods (LGU)
- g. **750** packs relief goods coming from DSWD 7

#### **NEEDS AND REQUIREMENTS**

- Tents and canopies for temporary shelter of evacuees
- o Handheld radios and extra batteries for communications
- o Back up power supply (generator set) for the motor siren functionality

#### **ISSUES AND CONCERNS**

a. Alternative livelihood of mostly fisherman.

#### **PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED**

- a. No standby generator for emergency purposes such as phone charging, tuning AM/FM radio.
- b. No back up battery for flashlights, transistor radios, camera, etc.
- c. Lack of protective devices, uniform and IDs for the damage assessment and inspectorate teams.
