The CBMS Network Coordinating Team of the De La Salle University (DLSU)-Angelo King Institute (AKI) for Economic and Business Studies in partnership with the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) will hold the 10th CBMS National Conference on March 24-26, 2014 at the Crowne Plaza Manila Galleria, Ortigas Avenue corner ADB Avenue, Pasig City.

The event will gather about 600 delegates to further strengthen growing partnerships among national government agencies, local government units, academe and research communities, non-government organizations, civil society organizations and other development partners.

This year's conference will feature the uses of the CBMS methodology for Grassroots Participatory Budgeting Process (formerly Bottom-Up Planning and Budgeting), disaster risk reduction and management, local governance, vulnerability mapping, program design, targeting and impact monitoring among others. Among the highlights of the conference is the annual recognition of good practices and innovations among LGUs in the institutionalization and utilization/application of CBMS.

In view thereof, all Local Chief Executives (LCEs) and other officials are strongly encouraged to attend. The details of the registration are as follows:

Live-In Registration Package: This includes 3 days and 2 nights (check in on March 24 and check out on March 26) hotel accommodation at the Holiday Inn Manila Galleria (located beside Crowne Plaza) with breakfast, lunch, snacks, arrangements and conference fees and materials.
