Situation Report: Effects of Typhoon "YOLANDA" in the Municipality of JAGNA

Date: November 8, 2013 as of 3:00 PM

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- At 1 PM November 8, the eye of Super Typhoon Yolanda was at the vicinity of Cuartero, Capiz (11.3 degN, 122.8 deg E) with maximum sustained winds of 200 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 230 kph.
- At 3PM, the eye of Typhoon Yolanda was located offshore of Tibiao, Antique (11.3 deg N, 121.9 deg E).
- Heavy rains with strong winds especially along coastlines

II. ACTION TAKEN

- i. Established Auxiliary Disaster Command Center at BPLO Office, Municipal Bldg., Jagna, Bohol and equipped with standby generator set, kitchen area, mess hall area, for rescue teams;
- ii. Activated Municipal Incident Command System (MICS);
- iii. Briefing of MDRRMC conducted at 6:00 PM in coordination with the coastal barangay captains, coastal BDRRM Officers, JEMRU personnel, 1st Bohol Ready Served Battalion, ROTC Officers of the University of Bohol led by Lt. Salaum, Philippine Army and Philippine National Police;
- iv. A total of 300 relief food packs containing rice, water and canned goods from the Jagna Convent ready for distribution;
- v. Conducted pre-emptive evacuation after monitoring the river and creeks' water level rise along Calmayon and Pagina-Looc River for possible flashfloods in the area;
- vi. Prepare Atrium of Jagna Business Center for evacuees from Brgys Pondol, Pagina and other neighboring residents;
- vii. JEMRU, TARSIER Group, Engineering Group and volunteers conducted monitoring of the effects of typhoon "YOLANDA" particularly the coastal barangays.

III. INCIDENT REPORT

- A. 3 partially damaged houses brought by the buhawi around 12:20 MN that hit Brgy. Cantagay, Jagna. Affected families are that of Edwin Madrazo, Guadalupe Madrazo and Ruben Fortuno.
- B. Total Electric Black out around 6:30 AM with advisory from BOHECO II due to NGCP, generator set is now being used.
- C. A fishing boat was found missing owned by Michael Sandoval from Initao, Misamis Oriental with 4 passengers including the owner. The other 3 persons namely Mr. Robert Salamanca (20 yrs old), Melvin Salamanca (13 yrs old) both from Pagina Seawall, Jagna, Bohol, and Mr. Jason Nalugon from Guindulman;
- D. Fallen electrical post at Balbalan, Pangdan and in Barangay Malbog, Jagna, Bohol;
- E. Started distribution of relief goods to evacuation centers in barangays with complete listing of evacuees.
- F. At 11:56 AM Barangay Capt. Teofilo Rana of Alejawan reported to the command center of the found fishing boat along Alejawan-Tubod Mar shoreline with the 4 missing persons found alive. The deputy incident commander conducted a short interview regarding on the details of the incident.
- G. JEMRU personnel with TARSIER volunteers in coordination with the Philippine Coastguard proceeded to Guindulman upon calls of assistance relayed by the Tarsier 117 of 2 drifting barges carrying limestone. There are 8 crews in LCT Big Champ. Another 8 crews were inside LCT Roger. All eight crews of LCT Roger abandoned ship. Seven were found alive while one was missing. Crews found drifting off LCT Roger are Jeffrey Berdigan, 27, patron, of Lapu-lapu City Cebu; Rodolfo R. Mendez, Jr., 29, wiper of Jagna, Bohol; Teddy N. Jimenez, 23, O/S of Kalibo, Aklan; Benjamin I. Arcipe III, 22, cook of Kayanoy, Masbate; Junel Galedo Sixti, 27, wiper of BElison, Antique; Rodrigo M. Perfas, 36, welder of C3 Caloocan; Christian P. Morales, 33, O/S of Placer, Surigao del Norte. Raffy C. Pelloño, 23, O/S of Altabas, Aklan is missing.

All eight crews of LCT Big Champ were rescued by Tarsier 117, Coastguard and JEMRU personnel. The eight crews rescued were Randy Dalumpines, 29, O/s of San Jose, Antique; Denmark Casampol, 23, O/S of Agotaya, Palawan; Junilo R. Capeyok, 25, wiper of Mayorga, Leyte; Jumiel V. Navarro, 23, welder of Aborlan, Palawan; Rhodel D. Taboda, 27, wiper of Guadalupe, Cebu; Vergel Yutrago, 20, cook of M.J. Cuenco Ave, Cebu City; Kenneth Mark V. Boral, 20, O/S of Real, Quezon Province and Gerovin Garingalao Pation, 41, patron of Gimbal, Ilo-ilo.

H. Conducted relief operations in the barangays: Cantagay, Pagina, Can-upao, Looc, Faraon, Alejawan and Naatang.
